Retired Attorney Steve Foran was in attendance and introduced Denis Kelly who was his replacement. Committeeman Wysong was out of town and unable to call in.

Mayor Leutwyler noted that there was only partial electric in the Court Room and no heat. This was due to an electrical problem outside at the pole. Jersey Central was called to take care of the problem.

Be it resolved that the following statement of Revenues and Appropriations shall constitute the Municipal Budget for 2014. The total of Appropriations and Revenue is in the amount of \$3,453,151.48 and the amount to be Raised by Taxes and also for Reserve for Uncollected Taxes is \$1,845,498.00. Be it further resolved that said budget will be published in the Asbury Park Press on April 2, 2014.

ON MOTION OF DEPUTY MAYOR SORCHIK, SECONDED BY COMMITTEEMAN TROTTA, RESOLUTION NO. 2014-140, A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PLUMSTED, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY FOR INTRODUCTION OF THE 2014 MUNICIPAL BUDGET WAS ADOPTED. ROLL CALL VOTE: ALL AYES

Mayor Leutwyler said a public hearing for the 2014 Municipal Budget Tax Resolution will be held at the Municipal Building on April 23, 2014 at 7:00 PM.

Mayor Leutwyler asked for further comments from the Committee; there was none.
