RESOLUTIONS:

ON MOTION OF COMMITTEEMAN WYSONG, SECONDED BY COMMITTEEMAN TROTTA, RESOLUTION NO. 2014-201 – AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE TO APPROVE THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR THE PLUMSTED POLICE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION CONTRACT (JANUARY 1, 2014 TO AND INCLUDING DECEMBER 31, 2016) AND TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT (JANUARY 1, 2014 TO AND INCLUDING DECEMBER 31, 2016) BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIP OF PLUMSTED AND THE PLUMSTED TOWNSHIP POLICE OFFICER’S ASSOCIATION, WAS ADOPTED. ROLL CALL VOTE: ALL AYES.

ORDINANCES:

ON MOTION OF COMMITTEEMAN WYSONG, SECONDED BY COMMITTEEMAN TROTTA, ORDINANCE NO. 2014-06 – AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PLUMSTED, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED “AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH SALARIES FOR VARIOUS OFFICIALS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PLUMSTED COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY REGULATING THE MANNER OF PAYMENT OF SAME”, WAS INTRODUCED. ROLL CALL VOTE: ALL AYES.

Before the roll call was taken, Business Administrator Dancer explained that on the last page of the ordinance there was language that the Committee had discussed previously. In the event the Governing Body determines it is deemed necessary to close the administrative offices due to inclement weather or a malfunction of facilities, regular part-time employees may be paid at their regular hourly rate of pay for their normal scheduled working hours.

Business Administrator Dancer asked the Deputy Municipal Clerk if there had been any correspondence received from the Police Officers Association with respect to the contract. She said no.

Mayor Leutwyler asked if there were any public comments; there were none.

Mayor Leutwyler asked for a motion to close the Township Committee meeting.
