Committeeman Lotito was absent and Deputy Mayor Sorchik was out of town. Mayor Trotta called in by phone.

There was one item on the meeting agenda. The Bill List of April 22, 2016 was presented; it included one bill from Wex Bank.

Committeeman Wysong asked for any discussion; there was none.

ON MOTION OF COMMITTEEMAN MARINARI, SECONDED BY MAYOR TROTTA, THE BILL LIST OF APRIL 22, 2016 WAS APPROVED AS SUBMITTED. ROLL CALL VOTE: ALL AYES.

Business Administrator Dancer asked the Township Committee to take a look at the administrative fees charged for off-duty assignments. For Township businesses that have an event and use an off-duty police officer, they are paying \$50 per hour. The administrative fee that is charged by the Township is \$100 per officer per day, except for the schools. Some of the businesses in town would employ more off-duty officers in our town and increase public protection if they didn't have to pay per officer, just the \$100 per day. Dancer said he would prepare something for the committee to consider before the next regularly scheduled meeting.

No public was in attendance so there were no other comments.
